Diego explained his \$1500 East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District grant proposal to remove non-native plants and plant natives in the King School parking lot. The approval date is flexible—30 days in advance could be enough to get the approval, which means Diego and volunteers could plant before the big fall/winter rains start. An Audobon plant sale on October 4<sup>th</sup> is where he'd like to buy the bulk of the plants. The plan is to leave the established trees on the property and also plant a few natives.

Alan left a message for the contracts person for Portland Parks and Recreation, trying to get an official sign-off to work in the parking lot, but hadn't heard back yet. There has been some confusion as to who can approve actions taken in the parking lot.

Diego said he would need a KNA representative to sign the grant proposal before it was sent off.

Lyndsey motioned that KNA sign the grant proposal as the budget was presented.
