In accordance with Article IV, Section B, of the by-laws of the King Neighborhood Association (approved by a vote of the membership July 9 2014), I am writing to notify you that I am scheduling a vote at the neighborhood association board meeting on March 8 2017 the purpose of considering whether to terminate your status as a member of the neighborhood association.

In accordance with the by-laws, and the procedures outlined in Oregon Revised Statutes 65.167, you are invited to provide a written response to this notification at any time before March 3 to the neighborhood association board. If you wish to do so, you may write to the board at the mailing address below, and I will ensure that all board members are shown a copy. If, instead, you wish to address the board in person, you may request from me five minutes at our regularly scheduled board meeting on February 8 2017, within which to address the board.

I believe that the on-going, long-term disruptive behavior you have engaged in, in your interactions with the neighborhood association, impedes the ability of the association to function effectively. A vote on terminating your membership will provide the board an opportunity to consider the relationship between your membership status, and the best interests of the neighborhood.
