Kristin had concerns about the Saltera development on Alberta Street and wanted to know the history of development.

Libby gave her the full history of the development and that at the time, the KNA had missed the opportunity to bring the developers in for a public presentation, which they're required to do if requested by the local neighborhood association. However, that would have been the extent of what the KNA could have done, other than for asking for a demo delay, which the KNA could have potentially delayed the project for a brief time. Many on the board were sympathetic and did not agree with the development. But it was pointed out that some neighbors supported the project and its not the KNA's job to promote an agenda but exists to support the concerns and desires of neighbors when there are such, or when there is a consensus.

But regardless, the development was fully underway at this point and those opportunities were long in the past.
